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YOUTH LEAGUE CODE OF CONDUCT FOR SPECTATORS & PARENTS

Most children participate in football activities for fun. They are not participating for the entertainment of spectators and/or parents only. The following Code of Conduct applies to all Parents and Spectators in attendance at youth football league matches.

1. Applaud good performance and efforts by all players. When watching a game congratulate both teams upon their performance regardless of the game's outcome.
2. Show respect for your team's coach, the referee, opponents and all other spectators and parents. Without them there would be no game.
3. Encourage players to play according to the rules and the official decisions, and develop your own knowledge of the rules. ALWAYS respect the Match Officials decision
4. Demonstrate appropriate social behaviour by not using foul language, and not harassing administrators, coaches, players, referee's all other spectators and parents. Condemn the use of violence at all times.
5. Remain outside the field of play and within the Designated Spectators' Area (where provided)
6. Let the coach do their job and not confuse the players by telling them what to do
7. Encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee and match officials
8. Avoid criticising a player for making a mistake - mistakes are part of learning
9. Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behaviour

I UNDERSTAND THAT IF I DON'T FOLLOW THE RESPECT CODE OF CONDUCT I MAY BE

- ✓ Issued with a verbal warning from a club or league official
- ✓ Required to meet with the club, league or County FA Welfare Officer
- ✓ Required to meet with the club committee
- ✓ Obligated to undertake an FA education course
- ✓ Obligated to leave the match venue by the club
- ✓ Requested by the club not to attend future games Suspended or have my club membership
- ✓ Removed

In addition:

- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and/ or suspension on the club.
